Why Kick Leuk?

On July 15, 2010, our world came crashing down. Our 15-year-old daughter Carly was diagnosed with AML (Acute Myeloid Leukemia), a leukemia more commonly diagnosed in adults.

For almost a year, Carly and our family would call C.H.O.P (Children's Hospital of Philadelphia) our home while trying to maintain a "normal" existence for our two sons who were 16 and 11 at the time.

We bonded with the other families on the oncology floor whose little cancer warriors were fighting each and every day to beat their disease. Seeing children and their families suffer with a terrible disease on a daily basis takes its toll. We were frustrated and infuriated that any child should have to fight for his or her life. But, it also gave us hope and encouragement to hear of success stories and to see the kindness and generosity of families, friends, and community.

Throughout the journey we have learned pediatric cancer research receives very, very little funding. We have also learned that Carly's diagnosis of AML is less common in children, making up about 15-20% of pediatric leukemias.

We formed the Kick Leuk Foundation to help fund pediatric leukemia research and to support families dealing with the disease. We are striving to make a difference by raising awareness about pediatric cancer. We dare you to join us!
